care & coverage

Since 2011, we have provided direct health care to 237 uninsured adults, an investment of \$1,298,966. We have awarded more than \$5.75 million to organizations through grants, donations and sponsorships. Through our Community Ambassador Program, Kaiser Permanente has 35 clinicians providing medical care at no cost in local clinics throughout the Mid-Atlantic region. There are two nurse practitioners supporting: Childrens' Project of DC.
